THE RITZ-CARLTON NEW YORK, NOMAD



Like any Ritz-Carlton, everything here is top-notch—from the views (north to the Empire State Building and south all the way to One World Trade) to the José Andrés restaurant, Zaytinya (a mix of Turkish, Greek, and Lebanese cuisine served in an open, white-oak-with-hints-of-blue space). She revived my face, even made some of my dark spots and broken capillaries less visible, and gave a fantastic lymphatic massage, too.
